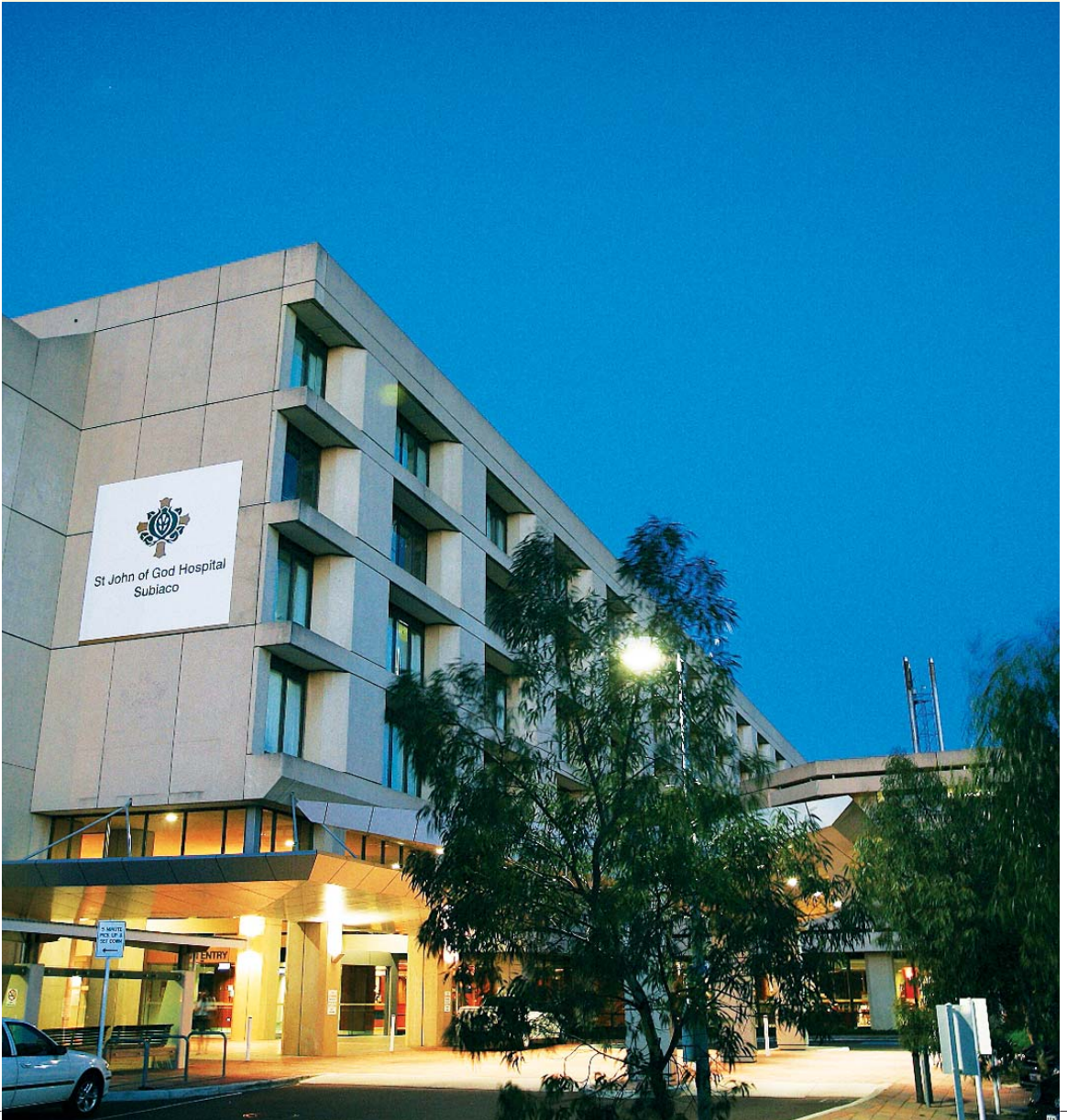

Established in 1897, St John of God Hospital Subiaco is a world class facility with a special focus on providing a warm and welcoming environment. Our nursing and midwifery caregivers are well recognised for their ability to combine compassionate, patient focused care with the highest levels of clinical excellence.

St John of God Hospital Subiaco is a comprehensive health care facility catering for a wide variety of specialty admissions. With more than 600 beds, the Hospital provides a range of clinical specialties and easy access to a range of on-site diagnostic services including radiology, pathology, MRI, nuclear medicine, ultrasound and two cardiac and vascular intervention laboratories.



Located on the Hospital site is the Bendat Family Comprehensive Cancer Centre, providing patients with the best 'coordinated' treatment for cancer in a pleasing environment and under the one roof. The Centre includes a dedicated oncology ward, day chemotherapy suite, brachytherapy suite, pathology services, Endoscopy Unit, consulting suites, research facilities and complementary therapies.



The Subiaco Clinic supports the Hospital with medical consulting rooms, a combined Operating Suite and Day Surgery Unit and a state-of-the-art Conference Centre. The Clinic also includes a primary care unit comprising a GP After Hours service, SportsMed, physiotherapy and a retail pharmacy.

More than 700 highly qualified medical practitioners are accredited to practice at St John of God Hospital Subiaco.

Support services

As a Catholic Hospital we are committed to focusing on the uniqueness of each person and in accordance with this, our dedicated Pastoral Services Department offers spiritual support as well as daily services for a variety of religious beliefs.

Our award winning Catering Department can provide specialised meals to suit any dietary, religious or cultural requirement. Our Clinical Dietitian is also able to provide assistance for specific nutrition related concerns or issues. For visitors and patients, the Hospital has two cafes – Pomegranate and Gallery – situated in the main Hospital entrance and Subiaco Clinic respectively.

The Hospital has a combination of private and shared rooms with luxurious modern décor to make our patients stay as comfortable as possible. Each room has an ensuite and it's own radio, television and telephone.

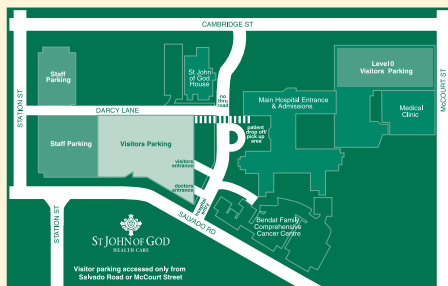
