Good morning Damien,

Just a quick email as we are finalising the department's response to the 2nd Independent Environmental Audit report for the St John of God Richmond hospital redevelopment project. You will receive the formal documentation via the NSW Major Projects Portal.

In relation to the previously provided contamination documentation, given this was mentioned in the project's response to the audit findings and the volume of information provided in May, we are continuing to review these documents and will look to provide further information to you as soon as is practicable. However at this stage there is no need for a meeting, as from the findings in the 2nd IEA report there has been no further contamination and minimal noncompliances (except for the non-compliances triggered by the previous failure to notify), and from what we have discussed previously the submitted documentation provides the identification, methodology and clearance/disposal documentation for each area. A meeting may be advisable if we require further information only in relation to each area.

However I am still happy to discuss over the phone if this assists, prior or once our consideration of the contamination information is complete.
