To ensure optimal clinical outcomes as well as timely diagnosis and ongoing support, they work in collaboration with each other and with our organisation's neurosurgeons and procedural pain specialists.

They are also supported by our world-class Procedural Pain Service, which assists in-patients with complex, acute and chronic pain, and educates patients and their family members about individual pain management.

The service also includes post-discharge care for those in chronic pain.

A history of innovation

Our specialists have access to leading technologies and innovations, allowing the most advanced techniques to be undertaken.

In 2016, St John of God Subiaco Hospital became one of the first hospitals in Australia to commission an Airo Mobile Intraoperative CT Scanner.

Most recently, we became the first private hospital in Western Australia to install an O-Arm mobile x-ray system.

The O-arm provides 360 degree, 3D images in real-time, and can be used at any stage before, during and after spinal surgery.

Enhanced imagery improves surgeons' visibility of anatomy, optimising clinical decision making and surgical accuracy.

We are currently the only private hospital in the State with this leading technology.
