St John of God Subiaco Hospital's Acute Cardiac Service, delivered in collaboration with Western Cardiology, provides a direct referral pathway for privately insured patients requiring urgent cardiac care.

Referring your patients ensures they receive immediate, specialist treatment in the comfort of a private environment, while also easing pressure on public hospital beds.

Who we care for

Privately insured patients presenting with acute conditions including:

- Chest pain
- Cardiac arrhythmia (e.g. bradycardia)
- Presyncope/syncope
- Suspected heart failure
- Pacemaker or cardiac device issues

Please note, we do not accept patients with STEMI through this service.

Why refer to us?

- 24/7 direct admission for acute cardiac conditions
- Immediate admission to our Coronary Care Unit
- Specialist care from Western Cardiology and dedicated cardiac nurses
- Supports public hospitals by diverting eligible patients to private care

Referral criteria

Available to patients with private health insurance referred by a GP, other medical practitioner or ambulance transfer service (subject to admission criteria).
